MANAGER / COACH

- Place the well being and safety of each junior footballer above all other considerations.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person and treat each equally within the context of the sport.
- Act as an ambassador for the club e.g. adhering to all guidelines laid down by the football governing bodies, consistently displaying high standards of behaviour and appearance, always promoting the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play) and never condoning violations of the laws of the game.
- Adhere to all guidelines laid down by governing bodies.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with each junior footballer based on mutual trust and respect.
- Encourage and guide junior footballers to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Ensure that the activities directed or advocated are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the junior footballers.
- Always promote the positive aspects of the game (e.g. fair play) and never condone violations of the laws of the game.
- Promote the fun of playing and never adopt a "win at all costs" approach.

- Let the Manager know in advance if you are unavailable for a game or training session.
- Pay attention to the manager and coach during training sessions and on match days.

- Inform the Manager as a matter of urgency of any updated junior footballers medical information, general of specific issue of concern or suggestions for improvement.
